I feel I need to offer some background to my mood on Thursday the 17th. I know you're aware that I suffer from depression and that sometimes it affects my mood at work. It came up when we were friends working at MHS and I know I brought it up in my formal job interview here in the context of our working relationship if I was offered the job.

About 3 weeks ago, I was prescribed an anti-depressant, one that I had never taken before. In hindsight, this medication made my depression more acute, especially during the week of my vacation and on Thursday the 17th. I called my doctor on Friday the 18th and he advised to taper off the medication immediately and stop taking it by Monday the 21st.

I hope that in the future, if you notice a problem with my behavior, or if its reported to you, that you'll consider first asking me about it to find out if there's some background to it.
